Sunday Worship Next Week at GSLC

Next Sunday (4/9) is Palm Sunday. As Jesus begins His final journey to Jerusalem, we continue our Lent journey to discovering God's undying love that was revealed on the cross. The Scripture readings for the services are: Daniel 4; Psalm 118:19-29; Philippians 2:5-11 and Matthew 21:1-9. The Praise Band will provide music at the 9:00 a.m. service. The organist will lead the music at the 11:00 a.m. service. The Chancel Choir will sing at the 11:00 a.m. service Pastor Ron will continue his sermon series on *A Faith that Never Quits* from Daniel. The sermon theme is "*A Kenotic Faith.*"

Holy Week Worship

The season of Lent concludes with Holy Week, the last week of our Lord's life on earth. On Thursday, which we call **Maundy Thursday**, Jesus met with His disciples for one last meal. He told them and us to observe a similar meal until we have a meal in heaven with Him. It is the Sacrament of Holy Communion. We offer that meal on April 13 at 7:00 p.m. **Good Friday**, the Friday of Jesus' last week, was when He was crucified. We will offer a service of darkness on April 14 at 7:00 p.m. The service will include the Chancel Choir and reflections on the sacrifice of our Lord for our sins. Bring a friend.

Two celebration services will be held at the usual worship time, 9:00 a.m. (Contemporary) and 11:00 a.m. (Classic). A brunch will be held between the services in the Social Hall.

Today's Readings Summaries

A summary theme for the appointed readings today (4/2) is: *Jesus Christ Is the Resurrection & the Life*. The illness and death of Lazarus happened "that the Son of God may be glorified through it" (John 11:4). Jesus' miracle of raising Lazarus prompted His arrest and crucifixion, whereby He would die "for the nation" and gather "into one the children of God who are scattered abroad" (John 11:51-52). As He called Lazarus from the tomb and commanded others to "unbind him, and let him go" (John 11:44), Jesus also calls us and releases us from the bondage of sin and death. We would not "submit to God's law," nor could we "please God" (Rom. 8:7-8), but "He condemned sin" in His own flesh, so "that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us" (Rom. 8:3-4). Now, through the Gospel, "the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells" in us (Rom. 8:11). His Word breathes His Spirit into our mortal flesh, animating us with His own life. As His ministers preach according to His divine command, the Lord Jesus calls us from the grave into the good land that He gives us (Ezek. 37:12, 14).
