Sonrise Singers

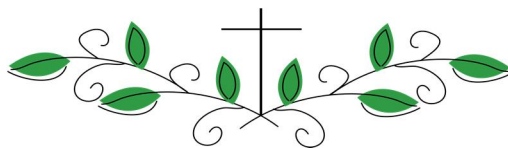

The entire musical; script, songs and choreography was developed in house at Bethany. They will be with us on June 10, 6:30 p.m.

In the musical My Extra Ordinary Life, we meet an orphan named Tara who has been shipped from foster family to foster family most of her life. She has always longed for that sense of belonging but growing up, realized no one really wanted her. Just when she has resigned herself to a life of loneliness without a family or home, her life collides full on with Matthew, a living example of God's deep, abiding, passionate love. Beginning with Matthew, God shows Tara just how much she is loved, and reveals his beautiful plan of adoption to her.



Today's Readings Summaries

A summary theme for the appointed readings today (5/31) is: *The Glory of the Lord of Hosts Shines in Mercy, Forgiveness, and Salvation*. When Isaiah "saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up," he cried out and confessed that he was "a man of unclean lips." If even the holy angels cover their faces in the presence of "the King, the Lord of hosts," how can sinful humans stand before Him? (Is. 6:1-5) Yet, the glory of the Lord is saving grace, and with "a burning coal" from the altar the angel touched Isaiah's lips, removing his guilt (Is. 6:6-7). Likewise, from the altar of Christ's Cross, by the ministry of the Gospel, "the whole earth is full of His glory" (Is. 6:3). For He was crucified, died and was buried, "according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God," and God "raised Him up, loosing the pangs of death" (Acts 2:23-24). He "received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit" (Acts 2:32) and He raises up the fallen world by pouring out His life-giving Spirit upon sinners through His earthly means of grace. To give this saving Gift God sent His Son into the world, "that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16-17).

2015 CNH District Convention

The Convention theme was "Run the Race - Eyes Fixed on Jesus." It was held April 17-19, with 330 pastors, delegates and visitors registering. Dr. Robert Newton was re-elected as District President, and Dr. Thomas Zelt was elected 1st Vice President. A main focus of the convention was Missions, with President Newton laying out the strategic direction for the next triennium, stating "Missions is proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus in places where the church isn't in charge." LCMS President Harrison discussed the current success in overseas missions, and Greg Finke described a "road map" for Missions. In addition to this call to mission focus, several resolutions were passed, including ones regarding communion, calling missionaries, and lay ministry. Focus was also placed on Hispanic Ministry, DMTF and other outreach programs.
