Oktoberfest is scheduled for October 30, 5:00 p.m., in our Social Hall. Plan on bringing a friend!

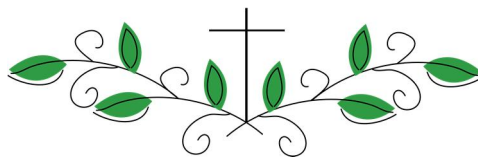


Assistive Listening Devices

Today's Readings Summaries

A summary theme for the readings today (8/7) is: **The Lord Is Surely Coming to Give You His Kingdom.** The Lord Himself was Abraham's shield and great reward. For "the word of the LORD came to him" and sustained the patriarch's faith in the face of death (Gen. 15:4). By divine grace, Abraham "believed the LORD, and he counted it to him as righteousness" (Gen. 15:6), on account of the holy Seed, Christ Jesus. To that one old man, the Lord granted "descendants as many as the stars of heaven and as many as the innumerable grains of sand by the seashore" (Heb. 11:12). The Lord is likewise faithful to you. It is His glad desire "to give you the kingdom" (Luke 12:32). Therefore, "do not be anxious about your life," but instead "seek his kingdom" (Luke 12:22, 31). Set your heart on that treasure. "Stay dressed for action and keep your lamps burning ... for the Son of Man is coming" (Luke 12:35, 40).

The team met on August 2:

- The financial report was reviewed. Everything is in order.
- The Turlock Pregnancy Baby Bottle fundraiser report should be available soon. Of the 75 baby bottles we distributed to people in the congregation, 50 were returned.
- A card was given to Bart Muller from the men at We Care Men's Shelter thanking him for his dedication to providing meals for them.
- The 2016-2017 Annual Agenda was reviewed.
- Plans for the ice cream social for children and parents were discussed. To date we have 61 people who will attend on 8/7.
- Our congregation will again provide dinners for the We Care Men's Shelter. They are increasing their open days to 9 months a year. They asked us to provide 6 more meals for a total of 17 meals (Sept.- May). We are checking with Turlock Gospel Mission to find out their plans and needs for meals and shelter for 2016-2017. We will have fund raising for the meals sometime this fall.
- The team briefly discussed the Comfort Dog Ministry. More information will be available for discussion at the Sept. meeting.
