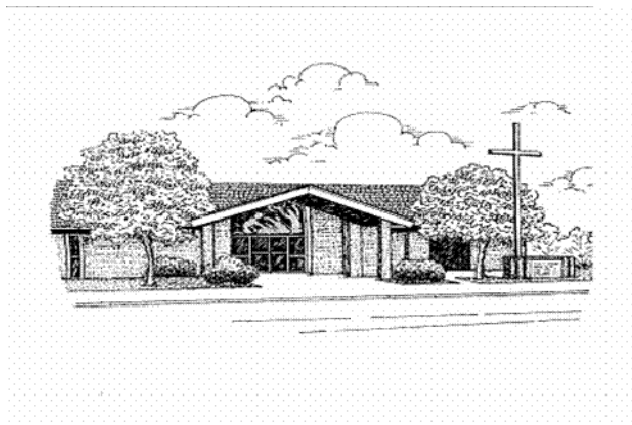

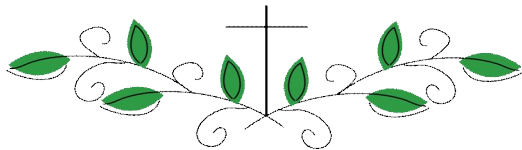

Sunday Readings Summaries

A summary theme for the appointed readings today (1/19) is: *God Reveals His Glory in Christ and His Cross*. "The LORD, the Redeemer of Israel" calls forth "his Holy One" (Is. 49:7), Jesus, the Christ, "from the womb" of His mother (Is. 49:1). The incarnate Son of God is revealed as the Savior, not only for Israel but also "as a light for the nations" whose salvation reaches "to the end of the earth" (Is. 49:6). John came "baptizing with water" (John 1:31) to reveal Jesus as "the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world" (John 1:29) and who glorifies His God and Father by His atoning sacrifice upon the cross. When Jesus was baptized in the waters of the Jordan, the Holy Spirit descended "from heaven like a dove" and "remained on him" (John 1:32). By our Baptism, we are anointed by the same Spirit, adopted by God the Father and "called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ" (1 Cor. 1:9). Therefore, we "are not lacking in any gift," but we can trust Him who promises to sustain us to the end, "guiltless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Cor. 1:7-8).

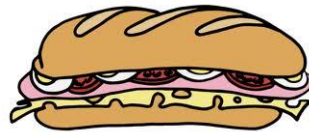

Outreach Ministries

The Outreach team met on Jan. 7.

- A job description for contacting our missionaries was developed: (1) monthly contact by email; (2) post recent newsletters on the missionary bulletin board; (3) insert information blurbs in News & Notes as often as needed.
- Dan & Patty Schmelzer, missionaries in Kenya, will be assigned a contact person soon. Two people have volunteered.
- New name tags will be ordered after finding a better tag than the current one
- The team discussed the costs for the LHM booklets that we provide for distribution through the chaplain at Emanuel Hospital.
- The Advent/Christmas advertising through banners, yard signs and business cards seemed to be a success. We will use them again next year.
- Offering popcorn and drinks at the Turlock Christmas parade was a success. We distributed many Christmas business cards. Next year we will only offer popcorn and hot chocolate.
- A request of \$650 to bring electricity to the national church office in Togo is being finalized.
- It was decided that Outreach will no longer fund Lifetree Café, since it has not been an outreach tool. The team hopes our congregation can offer it under some other ministry team.

- Easter advertising was discussed. We will distribute personalized flashlights at the Sunrise service. New Sunrise banners will be needed in the next few years.
- The Belize mission trip in April (4/21-4/26) is finalized. Fund raising will begin soon to help support the 6 missionaries who will represent our church.

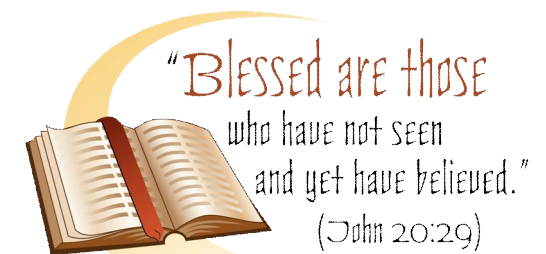
Elders

- Care Ministry needs cards were discussed.
- The involvement of the confirmed senior high members was reviewed.
- Pastor's Report.
 1. The small group report was presented. No discussion.
 2. Pastor has completed all course work for mission coach certification. It will be incorporated into his ministry to coach people in discipleship and leadership.
 3. The previous services (12/29/13 and 1/5/14) were discussed. The services and sermons were led by lay leaders, who did a good job.
 4. Rev. Mike Lange, our CNH District Missions Director, will be visiting our church on 2/2.
 5. A group from Teen Challenge will be with us on 2/23.
 6. The article, "Becoming an Inclusive Church," was reviewed. (It is available from Pastor.)
- The new procedures for handling the offerings at the close of a service were discussed. They seem to be good and workable procedures and will be continued.

- The use of songs during Holy Communion during the 9:00 a.m. service was discussed. Having the two musicians provide music during that time was seen as a good way to offer a time for meditation for the congregation.
- The Elder Lent service schedule for Wednesdays was set. (A description of the Wednesday worship services is provided elsewhere in this News & Notes.)
- An elder letter to the congregation was reviewed. It will be sent in February.
- The elders formed a list of people to ask to serve as elders. Two elders will complete their terms in June.
