Sunday Worship Next Week at GSLC

Next Sunday (3/2) is **The Transfiguration of our Lord** Sunday, the day when Jesus went up the mountain and revealed His glory as the Son of God. It was an overwhelming experience for the three disciples who were with Him. The appointed Scripture readings for that day are: Exodus 24:8-18; Psalm 2:6-12; 2 Peter 1:16-21; Matthew 17:1-9. The Praise Band will lead our music at the 9:00 a.m. service. The organist will lead our music at the 11:00 a.m. service. The Chancel Choir will be at the 11:00 a.m. service. Holy Communion will be offered at both services.

Lent Worship on Wednesdays – "Son of God: Who is He?"

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday (3/5). A 6:30 p.m. service will be offered for everyone. Holy Communion will be served. The following five Wednesdays will offer two times for worship on Wednesdays: a 12:30 p.m. formal, liturgical service and a 6:30 p.m. informal, contemporary service. The theme for all Wednesday services and Holy Week services will be the *"Son of God."* Clips of the movie "Son of God" will be used during each service. The movie opens in theaters on 2/28. You are encouraged to see the movie before the Lent series begins.

Lent Worship on Sundays

The Sunday worship services during Lent will focus on the theme **"Sons & Daughters of God."** We, who have been broken by sin, have been restored to the family of God by the Son of God.

Belize Mission Update

People in our congregation have given a total of \$1,430.00 to date for the mission trip to Belize, April 21-26. We have received \$1,500 in grants for the six missionaries (\$250/each) from the CNH District's Church Extension Fund. Also, we have \$1,271.49 in an account that was designated for short-term missions. That is a total of \$4,201.49. The total need to support the six short-term missionaries is \$9,912 (\$1,652/each). 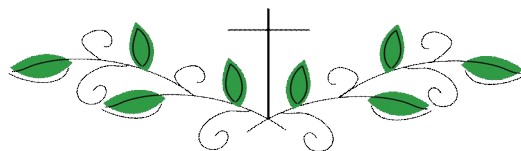

Today's Readings Summaries

A summary theme for the appointed readings today (2/23) is: *God Manifests His Perfect Holiness in Christ through Compassion and Forgiveness.* God reveals His perfect holiness in compassion as "he makes his sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust" (Matt. 5:45). By His grace in Jesus Christ, we are holy just as He is holy (Lev. 19:2) and we are "God's temple" in whom "God's Spirit dwells" (1 Cor. 3:16). This gift of holiness begins with fearing, loving and trusting God above all things, and it leads us to love our neighbor as ourselves (Lev. 19:18). No longer should we practice "injustice in court." No longer should we "be partial to the poor or defer to the great." No longer should we "go around as a slanderer" among God's people. No longer should we "take vengeance or bear a grudge" (Lev. 19:15-18). Though we were His enemies, our Lord Jesus Christ has loved us and forgiven us. Nourished and sustained by His holy body and blood.

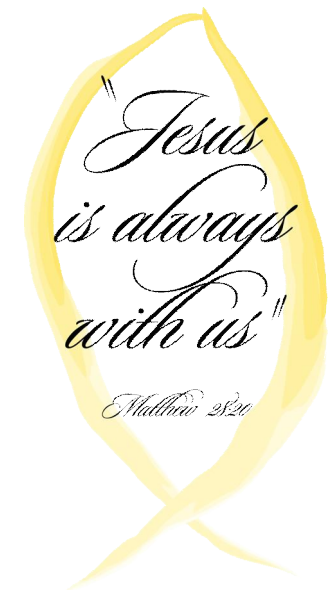
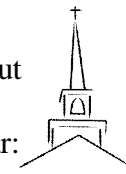

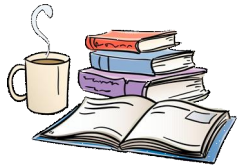
