The last week of Jesus' life was full of activity. In order to remember all the Jesus has done for us, we have set aside time for two worship experiences. We invite you to attend both of them. The worship services continue the Wednesday Lent service themes, "**Son of God: Who is He?**"

Maundy Thursday, 4/17, 7:00 p.m. The theme for our worship will be "**Lead us Not into Temptation – Man of Sorrows.**" Holy Communion will be offered during the service. At the conclusion of the service the altar area will be stripped to remind us of Jesus being stripped in order to be prepared for crucifixion.

Good Friday, 4/18, 7:00 p.m. The theme for our worship will be "**Deliver Us from Evil - Lamb of God.**" The Chancel Choir will perform the cantata "A Service of Darkness" by Dale Wood, which is a service of seven choral meditations on the last words of Jesus Christ. This will be a very reflective and meditative evening.

- The Financial Report was reviewed. No issues.
- Expenditures to date for the TGM Winter Shelter have been \$1,873.82;

contributions to date have been \$1,440. The remainder of funds (\$433.82) will come from the general fund. Many other people contributed food on the nights they served.

- A new coordinator for the Cookie drive for Prodigal Sons and Daughters is still being sought.
- The Turlock Police Chaplaincy will use our parking lot and restrooms for their annual marathon on April 12.
- Prescription cards are available at the Blood Pressure station on Sundays.
- The Adult Literacy Ministry is moving forward. Pam Youngdale and Beth Kirkpatrick will be the leaders. They have about 6-8 people who want to assist.
- Love Turlock on May 3 is being coordinated by Ayla Dillon.
- Ideas for new social ministry outcomes in our community were received through the yellow form. The people who made those suggestions are being contacted for further information and suggestions for implementation.
- The team added two outcomes for 2014-2015:
 1. Discover new ways to partner with Turlock Gospel Mission.
 2. Evaluate senior needs and available resources in our community.

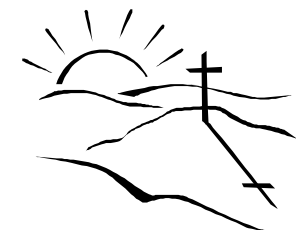
