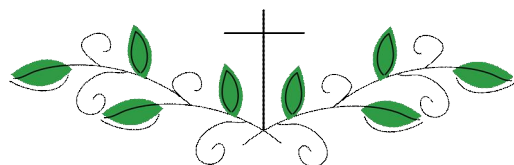

Today's Readings Summaries

A summary theme for the appointed readings today (6/15) is: *The Holy Triune God Recreates Us in the Image and Likeness of Christ Jesus*. The Holy Triune God "created the heavens and the earth," and "behold, it was very good" (Gen. 1:1, 31). However, after Adam and Eve fell into sin and plunged God's good creation into decay and death, the Son of God would be "delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God" to be "crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men" (Acts 2:23). As Jesus "received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit" (Acts 2:33), He also raises up all the baptized and pours out the Spirit upon them through the preaching of His Gospel. He sends out His Apostles to "make disciples of all nations" by "baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit," and "teaching them to observe all that [He has] commanded" (Matt. 28:19-20). Through such baptizing and teaching—Gospel and Sacraments—the Holy Triune God recreates us in the Image and Likeness of His incarnate Son, Jesus the Christ, and behold, it is "very good" (Gen. 1:31).

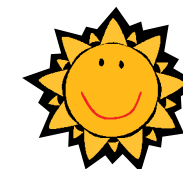

The Outreach team met on June 4.

- Missionary Wilson Koppula is still providing citizenship classes at our Cooper House, Mondays-Thursdays.
- The NEW Sunday name tags seem to have better adhesive.
- The LHM Booklet rack has been restocked in our Social Hall. More are needed for the rack at Emanuel Medical Center.
- Our website will be hosted by a different company soon. It will cut our costs significantly. Lacy Wallace continues to assist us with our website.
- Our Easter advertising was good. Our Easter banners are still in good shape.
- The Belize mission trip was a "success" and the presentation on 6/1 was well received.
- We are going to raise \$1,500 for Elohim Church in San Roman so they can bring electricity and water to their building and purchase chairs for seating.
- Initial plans are being made for a short term mission trip to Togo in June 2015. Four people are interested in participating on the two week mission. It might include training for pastors and rallies for children with VBS type events or rallies with churches. Fundraising will begin in September.

- The Jews for Jesus presentation on April 27 was reviewed. We thought it was too technical and might have been difficult for many people.
- Our congregation will provide a meal for MGF missionaries on 8/5 at 5:30 p.m.
