Belize Project

Thank you very much. The Belize Project is almost fully funded. Due to the generous donations of several people, the goal of \$1,500.00 has almost been reached. Elohim Church, the church our mission team worked with in April, will be able to bring electricity and water into their building. Also, funds will be used to purchase chairs.
