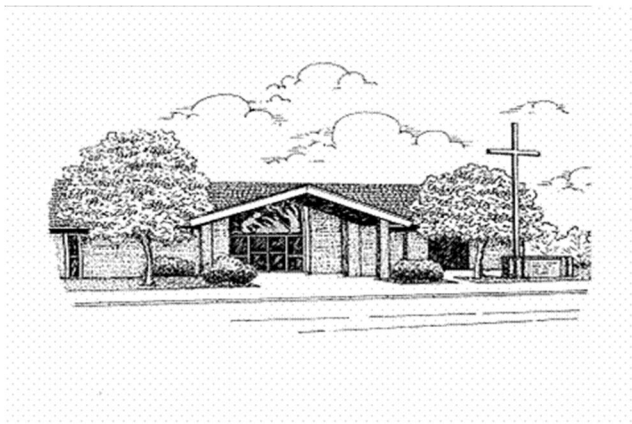

Togo Mission Trip Update

The dates for the mission trip to Togo, Africa, have been finalized. The team leaves on June 29 and returns on July 9. Three people are preparing for this mission trip. Each person will focus on a specific area of need for the people in Togo. Our team will work with 4 congregations for a rally day at each location and hold a 2-day seminar for the Lutheran pastors in Togo. The team will be unable to complete the electrical project for the Togo Lutheran Church office building. The estimated total financial need for the trip is \$8,000-10,000. (We are waiting on final estimates for costs in Togo before finalizing this figure.) Due to lower airfare the financial need has been lessened. We have received \$ 8,868.09 to date. Capital Funds

The Council approved two separate expenditures from Capital Funds. (1) Three replacement projectors are being purchased to replace the two in the sanctuary and the one on the cart. A total of \$5,000 was approved from Capital Funds and the remainder from the General Fund (Note: The actual cost will be \$5,132.45.) (2) Roof repairs are needed due to several leaks. Up to \$10,000 was approved. The estimate is \$3,800. However, due to possible unforeseen repairs the Council approved the additional funds.

Faith Basics

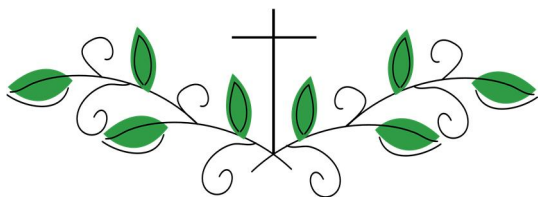
- FB 101 (4 sessions) – Who God Is: The Bible 4/28, 5/5, 5/12, 5/19

Today's Readings Summaries

A summary theme for the appointed readings today (4/12) is: *The Risen Christ Breathes His Peace in the Holy Absolution.* The crucified and risen Lord Jesus appeared to His Apostles on the first Easter Sunday. He “came and stood among them,” and with His Word and the wounds in “His hands and His side” He granted them His peace (John 20:19–20). He sent them as ministers of the Gospel in His name to bestow the life-giving Holy Spirit for us and for His whole Church through the forgiveness of sins (John 20:21–23). Through this apostolic ministry He calls us to believe that He “is the Christ, the Son of God,” so that by such faith we “may have life in His name” (John 20:31). The Apostles “have seen and heard” this divine life manifested in the flesh of Christ, and those who succeed them in this apostolic ministry now proclaim that same Absolution to us, so that we “too may have fellowship” with the risen Christ, with the Apostles, and “with one another” (1 John 1:1–7). The one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church lives by “their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus,” and all who believe this Word are “of one heart and soul,” because in Him they truly have “everything in common” (Acts 4:32–33).

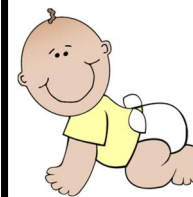
Biblical Garden Invitation
