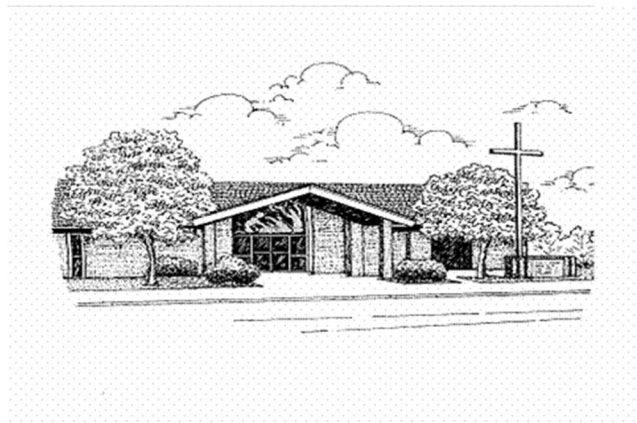

Lit 'n' Latte

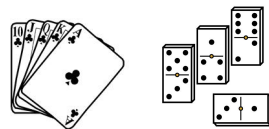

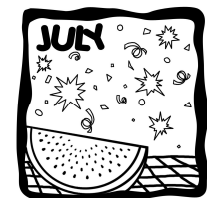
