Property Team

The team met on 3/29/16.

- New components for our sound system will be installed in the near future.
- The track lights in the sanctuary over the congregational seating will be replaced with LED lights.
- The property team budget for 2016-2017 was developed and will be submitted to the Stewardship Team.
- The team chose a SMART Outcome to address our congregation's Big Rock (goal) for Children and Youth Ministry: To establish a Sunday tech center that will be staffed by youth to provide services for congregational members.
- Costs for a new vacuum are being obtained.
- Yale locks will be replaced with Schlage lock cylinders.
- LED lights will be added in the Social Hall to increase the brightness of the current light fixtures.
- Brighter parking lot lights are being sought.
- Major capital needs were discussed for presentation at the May congregational meeting, including plans for new seating and floor covering in the sanctuary.
- A newer piano was donated to the congregation for use in the Fellowship Room. The older piano was donated to a family.

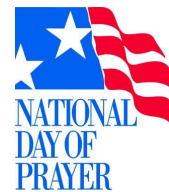

Today's Readings Summaries

A summary theme for the appointed readings today (4/10) is: *The Good Shepherd Feeds His Lambs*. "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain" (Rev. 5:12), who by His cross has conquered sin and death. With His blood, He has "ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation" (Rev. 5:9). This same Lord Jesus visits people of all nations and calls them to Himself by the Gospel, even as He "was revealed to the disciples after he was raised from the dead" (John 21:14). He restored Simon Peter to faith and life and commissioned him to feed His lambs and tend His sheep (John 21:15-17). Likewise, He revealed Himself to Saul of Tarsus and brought him to repentance, so that the persecutor of Jesus might carry and confess His name "before the Gentiles and kings and the children of Israel" (Acts 9:15-16).
