

ALASKA MISSION

The team will leave on July 28 and return on Aug. 5. The 11 people will serve in Wasilla, Alaska, with Pioneer Baptist Church and a local Bible Camp. The main project will be with Centershot Ministries, an outreach program that shares the Gospel of Jesus using the life-skill of archery. Crafts and Bible studies will be similar to what we do in VBS. Other service projects include handyman work at the church and Bible camp, adult literacy work, and sharing God's Word through New Heart Ministry (one-on-one sharing of God's Word.) Fundraising has provided \$10,603.
