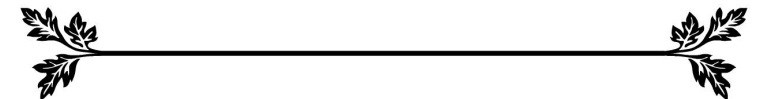

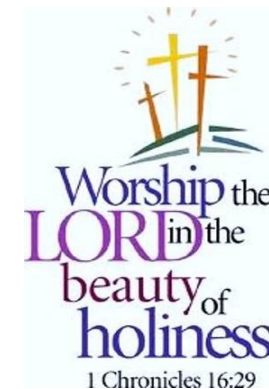

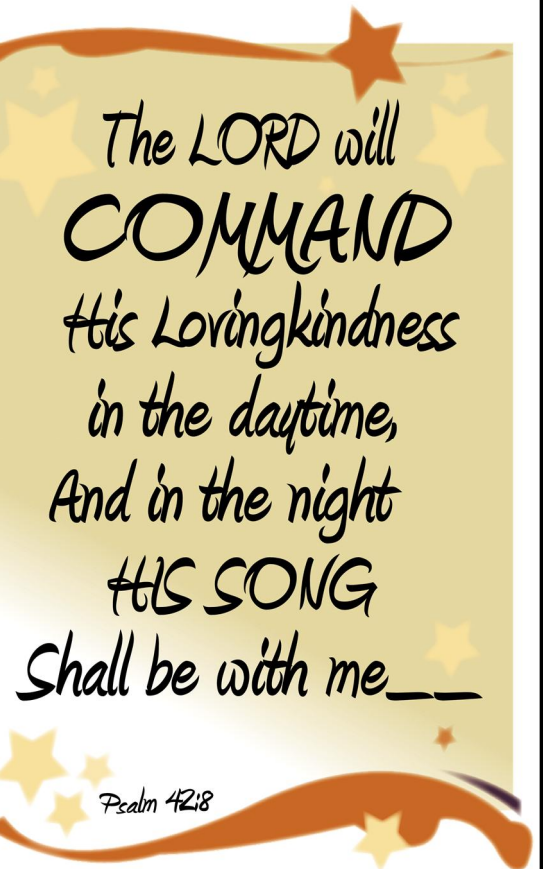
Council Meeting Summary
