WEEK 1: Wise Builder



BIBLE STORY:

The Wise and Foolish Builder: Matthew 7:24-27

BIBLE POINT: God's Word is Our Foundation



KEY VERSE:

Matthew 7:24 (ESV) "Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock."

Earn This Weeks Badge: Wise Builder: Bernard the Beaver

- It's time to build! Have your family help you build a fort. Take a picture of your fort and send it in if you can.
- Once your fort is set up read our Bible story inside (Matthew 7:24-27). What did you learn when building your fort? What did the people in our story learn while building? How is putting God's Words into practice like building a house on the rock?
- For your next activity you will need to find a rock. Maybe you have one in your house, maybe in your yard, maybe you can find one outside. Take some time to really look at your rock. Use your notebook to write down characteristics of your rock. Maybe it is grey, maybe it is smooth. Write down as many characteristics as you can. Next take some time to think about God. Write down as many characteristics about God as you can.
- For your next task you will need your Activity Page with the rock. Draw a picture of your home on the rock. Once your picture is complete pray over your picture that God would lead your household to build their lives on the firm foundation of faith in Him.

WEEK 2: Birdwatcher



BIBLE STORY:

The Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6:9-13.

BIBLE POINT: God Provides



KEY VERSE:

Matthew 6:26 (ESV) "Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?"

Earn This Weeks Badge: Birdwatcher: Rhonda the Robin

- Spend some time birdwatching. What do you notice about birds? What do they eat? How do they move? What do they sound like? Write down your answers in your "field guide".
- Build a "nest" inside out of things you have in your home. Blankets, pillows, get creative.
- Look up The Lord's Prayer and pray it in your nest. Thank God for things He has provided for you and the greatest gift of all- Jesus!
- Look up our Bible Passage Matthew 6:26. What does our passage tell us about the birds? What does it tell us about God? Write down your answers in your field guide.
- Glue pieces of grass or twigs to the Activity Page with the nest. Inside the nest draw a cross to symbolize the gift of Jesus that God provided. Take a picture of your artwork and send it in if you can.

WEEK 3: Star Gazer



BIBLE STORY:

A Psalm of Praise: Psalm 150

BIBLE POINT:

God Made Everything to Praise Him



KEY VERSE:

Psalm 148:3 (ESV) "Praise him, sun and moon; praise him, all you shining stars."

Earn This Weeks Badge:

Star Gazer: Gary the Grasshopper

- Set up a "stargaze station" outside. This could be as simple as a blanket on the ground. Take some time to look at the stars. What is the biggest star you see? What is the smallest star you see? Do you see any pictures in the stars? Take a picture of the night sky and send it in if you can.
- Look up our Bible Passage Psalm 150. What does our passage tell us about the stars? What does it tell us about God? How can we praise God? Write your answers down in your field notebook.
- Listen to the sounds outside. What do you hear? Do you like the sounds? What sounds do you think God likes?
- On the Activity Page with the star write or draw pictures of ways we can praise God inside the star. You could even write a song for God inside your star.

BIBLE POINT:

We Can Show Gods Love



KEY VERSE:

Matthew 5:16 (ESV) “In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.”

Earn This Weeks Badge:

Shine Your Light: Lumen the Lightning Bug

- Have you ever seen a lightning bug? Draw a picture of one on your Activity Page in the jar. Take a picture of your art and send it in if you can.
- In our Bible story we learned about a man who went out of his way to help someone. Think of ways you could help someone this week. Write them down in your field guide.
- Go on a scavenger hunt around your house and point out things that light up (flashlights, lamps, toys, candles). You could even go outside (maybe you'll see a lightning bug).
- Look up our Bible Passage Matthew 5:16 and read it aloud with your family. What does the Bible mean when it says that we are the light of the world? How can we share the light with others? Pray to God to show you how to let your light shine before others.

Earn This Weeks Badge: Jesus Is The Way


- Once you have collected the 5 previous badges check out the final video for instructions.

Jesus Is The Way


